

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Report ~ Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

MyComputerCareer.com/Techskills (OPE ID: 04206500) received education stabilization funds under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), HEERF II grants under the 2021 Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA, Section 314 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021), and HEERF III grants under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP). This Fund Report applies to the student portion received under the HEERF II & III that is designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.
